This notice is to inform you, because of recent complaints about criminal activities, (Break ins and disrespecting dealing) stemming from this complex. The New Haven Police Department will be imposing a lock down in this development at the request of the Housing Authority of the City of New Haven, the West Rock Development Corporation, Inc. and the residents.

What is meant about a lock down?

- Any car entering the development may be stopped and the car must be registered, insured and owe no taxes, the driver must have a valid driver licenses, if not, (the car will be towed at the owner expense).
- Every one stopped must have identification (ID) proof of residency or can verify whom they are visiting. Any one who cannot produce this information will be arrested for loitering or criminal trespassing.
- Any person charged with a crime or should be in school and is visiting your residence, you will face eviction. (No second chances)

This is our neighborhood/home and if we are not going to look out for each other, then we will have the master do it for us.

SHARP for this discussion and to answer any and all questions before the lock down starts. Your attendant is a must if you care about your family and community.
