the election laws of the State of Connecticut have been violated in the following manner,

Attached to this complaint is a letter sent to the RTM by two former DTC chairpersons, namely, Dan Baughman and myself. Additional attachments are an article in the New Haven Independent in which Ms Reed admits that she continued to run as a candidate for the RTM in the 5th District although at the time of the election she in fact lived in the 2nd District. Ms. Kiskaddon has now resigned from the RTM although she did live in the district in which she ran for but failed to remain as a resident of Branford. As an additional enclosure, I am sending a tape of the RTM meeting where our letter was read into the record and Ms Reed stood up and said she was innocent, which directly contradicts her statement to the New Haven Independent. It should also be pointed out that any conversation with Attorney Ed Marcus, if any took place, was according to Ms Reed in his capacity as Town Counsel. He did not become Town Counsel until Nov. 22, 2005, subsequent to the election. If in fact she had lived in the 5th and then moved after the election, there would be no issue. That was not the case. It is my belief that she is in violation of CGSA9-360 relating to Prudent Voting and CGSA9-361 relating to enrollment violations.
