

DeStefano Plans to Violate Federal Immigration Law—Make City Officials and Citizens Subject to Racketeering Charges



Mayor John DeStefano

Mayor DeStefano's plan for ID Cards for illegal aliens would subject every city official and private citizen distributing or accepting an ID Card to criminal charges and RICO lawsuits for inducing illegals to reside in the United States. (Public officials are not shielded from criminal misconduct.) They would be subject to private law suits arising from cases like these:

- Murder of an American citizen in Danbury by an illegal alien.
- Abduction and rape of a woman in Darien by one Mexican illegal that is now in CT prison and another who remains a fugitive in Mexico.
- Vehicular homicide of two teenage girls in Virginia Beach.

Title 8, Section 1324 --Bringing In And Harboring Certain Aliens (Excerpts)

(a) Criminal penalties--(1)(A) Any person who --(iv) encourages or induces an alien to come to, enter, or reside in the United States, knowing or in reckless disregard of the fact that such coming to, entry, or residence is or will be in violation of law; or (B) A person who violates subparagraph (A) shall, for each alien in respect to whom such a violation occurs - (i) ...in which the offense was done for the purpose of commercial advantage or private financial gain, be fined under title 18, imprisoned not more than 10 years, or both;

TITLE 18, PART I, CHAPTER 96 RACKETEER INFLUENCED AND CORRUPT ORGANIZATIONS (RICO)

As use d in this chapter—(1) “racketeering activity” means (F) any act which is indictable under the Immigration and Nationality Act section 274 (relating to bringing in and harboring certain aliens) section 277 (relating to aiding or assisting certain aliens to enter the United States)
