11. At "odd" intersection

- Straight across to West St.
12. Follow past Congress
13. RT at Davenport, then quick
14. LT onto Winthrop.
- Winthrop becomes Sherman.
15. Follow Sherman St. passed Hill-house High School to
16. RT on West Division
17. Continue across Dixwell to
18. Divison St.
19. LT onto Prospect St.
20. RT onto Canner St.
21. RT onto Nicoll St.

22. LT onto Lawrence St.
23. RT onto Mechanic St.
24. Cross State St. onto East St.
25. Follow to Humphry
26. LT onto Humphrey St.
27. RT onto James St.
28. RT onto Chapel St.
29. Continue to Green
