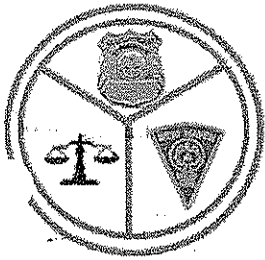

## **CRASH SUMMARY**

### **CONCLUSION:**

**BASED ON THE INFORMATION GATHER BY THE ABOVE OFFICERS AND SUBSEQUENT FOLLOW UP BY THIS SERGEANT, THE FOLLOWING DETERMINATION HAS BEEN REACHED:**

The photograph's taken by Ofc. Segui indicate that Asst. Chief Melendez's vehicle when backed up from the final rest position crosses over the double yellow line as it approaches the almost 90 degree left hand bend at the So. Orange/Columbus Ave. intersection. This may or may not have been the case. The final rest may have been affected by the sudden impact of the object and the driver's reaction to the impact. There were no skids to indicate direction of the vehicle. The camera angle(s) on the corner of the parking garage where inconclusive and did not pick up the vehicle until it came to rest. There were no witness's other than an oncoming vehicle from Union Ave. Under the victims own account, he acknowledged being in the middle of the roadway when he was struck. Based on the information obtained by the officers listed above, this investigation determines fault to be with Samuel Lewin for violation of Connecticut General Statute 53-182 USE OF HIGHWAYS BY PEDESTRIANS

**SITUATION:** An NHPD vehicle (CT #182XFM) vs. pedestrian crash that occurred on 11/22/2010 at the intersection of South Orange St. at Columbus Ave. Case # 10-74741 @ 18:02 hours

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**SUBJECT(S) INVOLVED:** Operator # 1: Assistant Chief Ariel Melendez of One Union Ave., New Haven CT. Pedestrian #2: Samuel Lewin D.O.B. 09/11/1989 of 37 Attawanhood Trail. Old Saybrook, CT.

**DETAILS:** A.C. Melendez was traveling southbound on South Orange St. (near Columbus Ave.) towards the intersection of Union Ave. Lewin was transported to Yale New Haven Hospital for his injuries. Sgt. Guliuzza activated the Crash Reconstruction Team. Sgt. Moeller was also on scene. Officer Steve Manware, Officer Jon Young, Officer Betsy Segui, and Officer Lloyd Barrett all responded from the Crash Reconstruction Team.

**INVESTIGATION:** Officer Steve Manware recorded measurements with the Total Station and completed a Field Sketch. Officer Betsy Segui photographed the scene and also recorded measurements. Sgt. Moller was Car 9 Shift Supervisor and started a PR1 which will be followed up by Sgt. Guliuzza. Officer Jon Young went to Yale New Haven Hospital to meet with Lewin. A medical status check was done on Lewin's condition at Yale New Haven Hospital. At this time it appeared Lewin's injuries were non life threatening. Lewin's injuries are listed as followed: a broken jaw, fractured skull, and numerous lacerations to his head.

Sgt. Guliuzza will handle the primary investigation.

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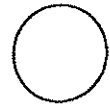

Pedestrian: Lewin stated that he had just exited his vehicle, which was parked on South Orange St., and was walking in the roadway to Sadavi's. (A store located inside the Church St. Housing Complex). The next thing Lewin knew, he had been struck by a vehicle and thrown to the ground.

Operator 2: Melendez stated he was traveling south on South Orange St. and was making the turn onto Columbus Ave., when all of a sudden, something struck his windshield. Melendez stated that he immediately stopped his vehicle, at first believing someone had thrown a brick at it, however, upon exiting his vehicle, Melendez observed Lewin lying in the roadway. Melendez then called for medical personnel. Melendez stated that he never observed Lewin walking in the roadway.

Witness: Worthy stated that he was traveling west on Columbus and was about to turn onto South Orange St., when he observed Lewin stumbling in the middle of the roadway and fall to the ground. Worthy stated that prior to that, he did not observe anyone walking in the roadway.

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ON 11/23/10, I spoke with ASSISTANT CHIEF MELENDEZ REGARDING THE ACCIDENT THAT OCCURRED THE PREVIOUS DAY. HE REITERATED WHAT HE HAD TOLD TO Sgt. Moller. HE HAD JUST LEFT HIS OFFICE AT WORK (NHPD HQ). HE EXITED THE PARKING GARAGE AND PROCEEDED DOWN SUMNER STR. TO THE So. ORANGE ST. INTERSECTION WHERE HE STOPPED THEN MADE A LEFT HAND TURN. HE PROCEEDED ON So. ORANGE TO THE LEFT HAND CURVE ON TO/INTERSECTING COLUMBUS AVE. AS HE ROUNDED THE TURN, HE HEARD/ FELT SOMETHING STRIKE THE WINDSHIELD. HE STOPPED HIS VEHICLE. 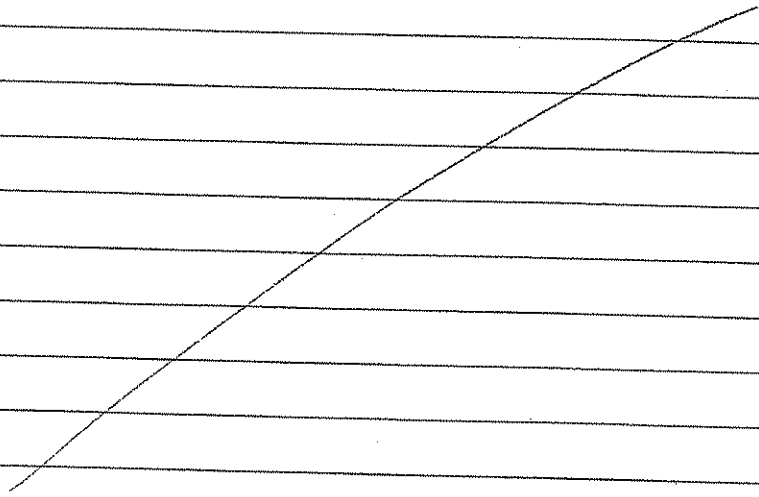

ON 11/24/10 @ APPROXIMATELY 0900HRS, I CONTACTED YALE NEW HAVEN HOSPITAL TO OBTAIN AN INJURY STATUS REPORT UPDATE ON SAMUEL LEWIN (09/11/89). I SPOKE WITH ER/RECORDS PERSONNEL. THEY INFORMED ME THAT MR. LEWIN'S INJURIES WERE "FACIAL AND SCALP CONTUSIONS" ONLY AND IN NO WAY WERE THEY EVER LIFE THREATENING OR SERIOUS IN NATURE. IN FACT, THEY ALSO INFORMED ME THAT MR. LEWIN WAS NEVER ADMITTED INTO THE HOSPITAL. HE WAS TREATED AND RELEASED EARLY IN THE AM OF THE DAY FOLLOWING THE ACCIDENT (11/23/10). THIS IS CONTRADICTORY TO WHAT WAS INITIALLY REPORTED IN THE INITIAL MEMO BY DTC. BARRETT. IT IS UNCLEAR AS TO WHO INITIALLY REPORTED THE INJURIES.

CASE INCIDENT REPORT (Narrative)

On November 22, 2010, at approximately 1830 hours, I responded to the intersection of South Orange Street and Columbus Avenue for a motor vehicle crash involving a pedestrian.

The motorist, who was identified as Ariel Melendez, was not injured. The pedestrian, who was identified as Samuel Lewin, suffered serious head injuries and was subsequently transported to Yale New Haven Hospital for treatment. I went to the hospital and spoke briefly with Mr. Lewin. He gave the following account: Prior to the crash, he was at a house party. He was asked by his friend, Carlos Saint Johns, for a ride to Sadavi's Market (located at 89 Union Avenue). Mr. Lewin drove Mr. Saint John to the store. He parked his car on the west side of South Orange Street, near Columbus Avenue. Mr. Saint John then exited the car and walked toward Sadavi's. After approximately ten minutes, Mr. Lewin felt Mr. Saint John was taking too long, so he exited his car, and walked toward Sadavi's to try and find him. Mr. Lewin was not sure exactly what route he took as he walked toward the market. He said he was in "the middle of the road" when he was struck by a car.

Mr. Lewin was unable to provide any further details regarding the crash.

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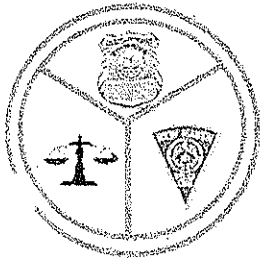
Captain Peterson,
