- 9. **Assignment of Contract** The contractor may assign all or part of the contract to another after receiving written permission from the City Purchasing agent. Such assignment shall NOT release the contractor from any part of the responsibility or liability assumed under the contract.
- 10. **Equal Employment Opportunity** The City will terminate any contract without accepting liability for any incomplete work if it is found that the Contractor has violated any of the provisions of Executive Orders 11246 and 11374, Connecticut Fair Employment Practice Act, and Chapter 12½ of the code of Ordinances of the City of New Haven, incorporated herein by reference. The City reserves the right to incorporate into the contract any additional provisions relating to Equal Employment, including an Affirmative Action Agreement
- 11. **Implied Requirements** All services not specifically mentioned in this RFP that are necessary to provide the functional capabilities described by the vendor shall be included in the Proposal. The City does not reimburse for expenses incurred during the performance of this contract. It is the contractor's responsibility to notify the City of New Haven, Bureau of Purchases within a minimum of 7 days of the opening date of any services or supplies not specifically mentioned in this specification but are necessary to provide the functional capabilities of the contract.
- 12. **Preparation Costs** All costs incurred in the preparation and presentation of this Proposal shall be wholly absorbed by the proposer.

13. Insurance

A. The Contractor will carry Professional Liability or Errors & Omissions Insurance with respect to any damage caused by an error, omission or any negligent act of the Contractor with minimum coverage limits of One Million Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000,000.00) per claim for any wrongful act to cover work performed under this contract.

Upon signing this Agreement, the Contractor shall provide a certificate of insurance evidencing said insurance. Upon request, the Contractor will promptly provide the City with a copy of the insurance policy. It is understood that the Contractor shall not change the terms and conditions of such insurance

policy except upon the prior written approval of the City, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

- "Tail" Coverage: If any of the required liability insurance is on a claims made basis, "tail" coverage (Extended Reporting Period) will be required at the completion of this contract for a duration of 24 months, or the maximum time period reasonably available in the marketplace. Contractor shall furnish certification of "tail" coverage as described or continuous "claims made" liability coverage for 24 months following Contract completion. Continuous "claims made" coverage will be acceptable in lieu of "tail" coverage provided its Retroactive date is on or before the effective date of this Contract. If continuous "claims made" coverage is used, Contractor shall be required to keep the coverage in effect for duration of not less than 24 months from the end of the Contract.
- **B.** The Contractor shall indemnify, defend and save harmless the City and its officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to attorney's fees arising out of or resulting directly or indirectly from the performance of services of the Contractor set forth under this Agreement.
- **C.** The Contractor, shall, in addition carry Commercial General Liability insurance providing for a total limit of one million dollars and no cents (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence for all damages arising out of bodily injury and property damage, and contractual liability for the indemnification provided under this contract; Personal and Advertising Liability \$1,000,000 per occurrence; Products/Completed Operations \$1,000,000 aggregate; Fire Damage Legal Liability (where required) \$300,000; Medical Expense \$10,000. Each annual aggregate limit shall not be less than one million dollars and no cents (\$1,000,000.00).
- **D.** The Contractor shall carry Automobile Liability insurance with respect to any owned, non-owned, or hired vehicles in the amount of one million dollars and no cents (\$1,000,000.00) per accident for bodily injury and property damage.

The City shall be named both certificate holder and additional named insured. The certificate shall specifically reference this Agreement, and should any of the above described policies be cancelled before the expiration date thereof, notice will be delivered in accordance with the policy provisions.

- **E.** The Contractor shall furnish the City with a certificate of Insurance evidencing that it has complied with the obligations under this section of the Agreement. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for the payment of all premiums.
- F. Where required by statue, the Contractor shall carry Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability with limits of not less than the following: Each Accident \$100,000; Per Disease Policy Limit \$500,000; Disease each employee \$100,000. The City shall be named a Certificate Holder on such policy, and the Contractor shall furnish the City with a Certificate of Insurance evidencing that it has complied with the obligations under this Section of the Agreement.
- **G.** City of New Haven must be named as an additional insured and the Certificate of Insurance must include the contract name, number and location.
- 14. **Availability of Funds** All contracts are bid with the intention of awarding a contract as a result of the RFP. Any and all awards and actual contract execution by the City Of New Haven is contingent upon availability of appropriate funds. In the event that funding is not available at the time of award and/or execution of the contract the City reserves the right to cancel the bid.
- 15. **Execution of Agreement** Failure of the successful respondent to deliver to the City a properly signed and witnessed Agreement with all required bonds and insurance policies, within ten (10) days after receipt of written Notice of award, or within such extended period as the Purchasing Agent may grant, shall constitute

a default, to the City, which may either award the contract to the next lowest respondent, or re-advertise for RFPs.

- 16. **Commencement of Work** The City will not be responsible for payment of any work performed or materials supplied by the successful respondent before the Contractor receives a fully executed agreement unless an emergency situation has been declared by a City employee duly empowered to do so, and the vendor receives written authorization from this individual to proceed. Note: Responsibility for payment shall be limited to only that work deemed necessary by the City to alleviate the immediate emergency.
- 17. **Local Preference** All else being equal, preference for New Haven based businesses, pursuant to Section 2-153 of the New Haven Code of Ordinances, will be given. This will be determined on a case by case basis dependent upon the source of funds targeted to pay for this service.
- 18. **Agreement Term** the term of this agreement as a result of this RFP unless indicated elsewhere in this RFP shall be for one Fiscal year with an option to renew for 2 additional one year periods at the same terms and conditions at the sole discretion of the City of New Haven.
- 19. **Procurement Card/ PCard (e-commerce tool).** Please indicate in your Statement of Qualification if your firm is enabled to accept credit card payments for goods and service, in addition to Purchase Order or Checks. Please provide any applicable discounts in your response.

I. Introduction and Background

The City of NEW HAVEN requests responses for the implementation of a design-build facility renovation program in City owned facilities noted above, in accordance with the letter of this public notice. Specifically, the FIRM selected as a result of this Request for Proposal (RFP) will be expected to:

- 1. Provide comprehensive design-build services for City-owned facilities, to include the following:
 - a) Program development
 - b) Design, selection and installation of equipment and systems
 - c) Program management
 - d) Possible maintenance and service of the installed systems
 - e) Provide guaranteed funding sources.
 - f) Firm fixed price contract
 - g) Training, support and education of The City of NEW HAVEN's staff
- 2. Structure the terms of The City of NEW HAVEN's payment obligations for these improvements and services so that there are no upfront costs associated with the project. FIRM to identify and provide funding sources for up to 100% of the project costs, which do not include increasing any tax assessments or new service fees, and the funds identified must be guaranteed to match or exceed the annual debt service fee.
- 3. Provide a firm-fixed price, design-build program with no change orders on CITY's agreed scope of work. The scope will be developed once a firm is selected.

Upon review of Responses to this RFP, The City of NEW HAVEN will select a single FIRM to provide Design-Build services for City-owned facilities noted in this document.

A. Purpose

This Request for Proposal requires the selected provider to create a design-build program that provides the necessary, engineering concepts, implementation, project management, guaranteed funding and on-going support and training required to fulfill the requirements of this program.

B. Statement of Intent

The intent of this project is to provide the City with the means to improve its designated facilities without the requirement of capital funding or pledges of new tax revenues.

C. Type of Contract

It is required that if a contract is entered into as a result of this RFP, the structure will be a design-build agreement with guaranteed performance obligations. The Owner will undertake negotiations with the FIRM whose understanding, proposal, and experience in this arena demonstrates their qualifications and history of performance and have achieved the results other cities have demanded. The City of NEW HAVEN reserves the right to consider responses or modifications thereof, received at any time before award is made to the selected FIRM, if such action is in the best interest of the City. The City of NEW HAVEN reserves the right to reject any and all responses.

D. Design-Build Defined

For the purposes of this document, "design-build program" means a contract for project concept, engineering, project management, implementation, guaranteed funding, on-going support, and training required to achieve the results represented by the selected provider.

E. Issuing Office

This RFP is issued for and by The City of NEW HAVEN. The City of NEW HAVEN will coordinate all phases of the project and will provide names of contact persons and other information as required.

II. THE SELECTION PROCESS

A. Timetable

The City of NEW HAVEN expects to undertake the selection process described below according to the following schedule:

Submission of Responses <u>October 7, 2014</u>

Selection of FIRM

October 14, 2014

Each of these steps in the selection process is described in the selections that follow.

B. Submission of Responses

Interested FIRMs will submit Responses as described in Sections III and IV below.

C. Evaluation

The Selection Committee will evaluate all Responses. The Selection Committee will make a final selection based upon factors that are deemed to be in the best interests of the City.

Responses will be evaluated and scored on the basis of the following criteria, which will be accorded the relative weight indicated in parentheses:

1. Experience and Qualifications (maximum 20 points)

- a. Preference will be given to respondents demonstrating strong capabilities, experience and reputation in undertakings similar to those described in this RFP, and providing authoritative documentation of the respondent's financial condition and stability. Specifically, the respondents shall list clients where similar projects have been successfully implemented and monitored. Preference will be given to respondents that have been in business for over 50 years.
- b. Furthermore, because of the desired response capability the FIRM must have five or more References in the last five years.

2. Technical Approach (maximum 30 points)

a. Responses should provide a general description of the technical approach to meeting The City of NEW HAVEN's objectives. Responses should also outline the respondent's project development process and how it collaborates with and maximizes financial benefit to the City and minimizes risk. Respondents should include a description of their responsibilities for maintenance and repair of equipment and systems following installation, and should demonstrate the ability of the respondent to provide service on both a routine and emergency basis. Respondents should demonstrate their capabilities and methodologies regarding the concept, design, implementation, training, staff support, management and associated programs proposed for the City.

3. Staff Rating (maximum 15 points)

a. Points will be awarded based on documented technical and project administration skills and experience of the proposed project team. Only those individuals proposed to work directly on the subject project should be included in the Staffing Plan.

4. Financial Capability Rating (maximum 30 points)

- **a.** Points will be awarded based on the demonstrated financial strength of the proposer, which will include the proposer's bonding capacity, and the most recent year ending financial statement.
- b. Firm must have a balance sheet demonstrating operating cash and assests valued at \$3 billion or greater.

5. Pricing (maximum 5 points)

a. Points will be awarded based on the cost to provide the investment grade analysis (contract ready). The analysis must include final concept, design, development, implementation, and guaranteed funding.

C. Proprietary Information

If a submittal includes any proprietary data or information that the respondent does not want disclosed to the public, such data or information must be specifically identified as such on every page on which it is found. Data or information so identified will be used by The City of NEW HAVEN solely for the purposes of evaluating responses and conducting contract negotiations.

D. Right to Reject

In submitting this response, it is understood by the respondent that the right is reserved by The City of NEW HAVEN to accept any response, to reject any and all responses, and to waive any irregularities or informalities when to do so is in the best interest of The City of NEW HAVEN.

IV. Response FORMAT AND CONTENTS

Responses must be submitted in the format outlined in this section, with each of the described forms and sections completed in full (except those sections described as optional). Respondents not utilizing this format will be considered non-responsive. Each response will be reviewed to determine if it is complete prior to actual evaluation. The City of NEW HAVEN reserves the right to eliminate from further consideration any submittal deemed to be substantially or materially unresponsive to the requests for information contained herein.

Each of the forms and sections described below should begin on a separate page, and each page should clearly state the name of the respondent in the upper right corner.

A. Respondent Background and Qualifications

Section A of the proposal should contain the following information about the respondent:

- 1. Information about the respondent (addresses, telephone numbers, and names of contact persons and of the Staffing Team) should be provided on Form I.
- 2. Resumes for each of the individuals listed as lead personnel for the respondent's project team on Form I should be included in the proposal.

- 3. Prior relevant work experience of the respondent should be included in the proposal and should include the following information (if more than five projects are relevant to this RFP, remaining examples of experience may be briefly summarized):

VENDOR "BAN THE BOX" ORDINANCE COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT

The City of New Haven is subject to Ordinance #1585 (2/17/2009) which prohibits unfair discrimination in City hiring policies against persons previously convicted and provides a mechanism to ensure that persons and businesses supplying goods and/or services to the City of New Haven have adopted and employ fair hiring policies and practices that are consistent with the City's goal of removing obstacles to the employment of persons with prior convictions.

- (B) Under exigent circumstances, an Awarding Authority, by its highest ranking member, in consultation with the Office of Corporation Counsel and the Community Services Administration, may grant a Vendor a waiver of the criminal history standards on a contract-by-contract basis. A written record of the waiver shall be kept on file by the Awarding Authority, the Community Services Administration and the Office of Corporation Counsel, and shall also be submitted to the City of New Haven Commission of Equal Opportunities. The written record shall include, but not be limited to: (a) a summary of the terms of the contract, (b) the details of the Vendor's failure or refusal to conform to the City's criminal history standards, and (c) a brief analysis of the exigency causing the grant of waiver. No waiver may be considered perfected unless the Awarding Authority fully complies with the provisions of this subsection.
- (C) A Vendor may contact the Community Services Administration to report any problems, concerns or suggestions regarding the implementation, compliance and impact of these sections, and the Community Services Administration shall log every comment received with a summary of the comment and shall keep on file any written comments.
