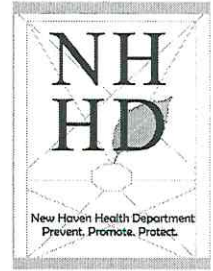

Section 8 Inspection
Fact Sheet for Homeowners

- Lead Inspection Request is received from Raquel Santiago of L.C.I.
- Lead Inspection Request is forwarded to the Lead Inspector (**the same day a request is emailed**) of that area to schedule an inspection with homeowner. The homeowner also has the option to hire a certified firm to conduct an inspection. (**contact will be made within a day or two**)
- The Lead Inspector will test painted surfaces for lead utilizing an LPA-1 XRF device.
- A report of the Lead Inspector's findings will be forwarded to the homeowner and a listing of corrective action if lead is found. (**a day or two from inspection being completed**)
- Once the homeowner or certified lead abatement contractor completes the work a re-inspection to collect clearance dust wipe samples will be scheduled (the cost of sampling and mailing of these samples will be borne by the homeowner. Approximately \$150). (**depends on homeowner**)
