Yale University will make a public commitment to hire 1000 people into full-time permanent jobs from New Haven neighborhoods. 500 will be from the following listed neighborhoods of need.

Neighborhoods of need include the following census tracts:


Census Tract	Neighborhood
1402, 1403, 1404, 1405, 1406	The Hill
1407, 1408	Dwight, West River
1413	West Rock
1415, 1416	Newhallville, Dixwell
1423, 1424, 1425	Fair Haven

These hires would come primarily through New Haven Works.


Yale and New Haven Works will review this agreement in July 2017 to evaluate the job creation progress. New Haven Works and Yale University will report jointly on an on-going basis. The review process is open to the New Haven Community.


Any portion of these jobs may come from construction projects in coordination with the Building Trades and Yale University provided the jobs are full-time and on a permanent building trades apprentice track.
