The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection ("the Department"), has received your letter regarding the above-referenced facility and the pending application. Your letter was received on June 27, 2019 and expresses your concerns regarding the specific modification sought by Murphy Road Recycling, LLC ("Permittee"), to authorize the receipt, storage and consolidation of putrescible municipal solid waste at the facility and the transfer of such waste from the facility located at 19 Wheeler Street in New Haven.

Staff of the Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division of the Department ("WEED") is in the early stages of the technical review of the application. Enclosed, please find a brief description and flowchart of the WEED's process for the review of solid waste facility applications. The above application is currently in the process step highlighted in green.

The Department has noted the concerns that you have expressed and understands that they are shared by other local officials.
