APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTION


TO THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF NEW HAVEN:

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 52-471 et seq., and Conn. Gen. Stat. § 22-363, the Plaintiffs, Petisia Adger, Eric Colon and Evenilda Ortiz, hereby request that a temporary injunction issue, without bond and in accordance with the request made in the prayer for relief in its accompanying Verified Complaint enjoining and restraining the Defendants, together with their members, officers, employees, and agents: (a) from allowing or permitting dogs at the Facility to use, access or occupy the Outdoor Dog Pen (as those terms are defined in the Verified Complaint); (b) from opening the overhead garage doors that connect the interior of the Facility to the Outdoor Dog Pen; and (c) from otherwise violating § 18-75(a) of the New Haven Code of Ordinances, § 7-5 of the New Haven Code of Ordinances or Conn. Gen. Stat. § 22-363.

The Plaintiffs further request that an Order for Hearing and Notice be issued requiring the Defendants to appear before the Court at an early date to show cause why such temporary injunction should not issue and remain in effect during the pendency of this action.

In support hereof, the Plaintiffs have filed a Verified Complaint, the allegations of which are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein. In accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. § 52-471(b) the facts stated therein have been verified by the oath of the Plaintiff.
